Talladega Gran Prix in April. We are doing a few things a little different this year. This year we are capping the event at 36 cars for the day. 4 groups of nine cars so we can maximize everyone's track time. We will also be asking for folks who would like to work for track time. We need 16 people who would be willing to work half a day for half a day of track time. \$30.00 registration for these spots. First come - first serve. We are extending this offer to club members first and then we will be contacting the SCCA for workers. These workers will mostly be working corners and the stations around the track. If you would prefer to pay for the whole day (\$165.00 for club members and \$175.00 for non members) and run all day - please don't hesitate. We will still need some other folks to fill in throughout the day as needed to help out with lunch, hospitality, and instruction. Rick and Leah have volunteered again to spearhead our free lunch. For those of you who haven't been to one of our track days, I would encourage you to come out and participate. Our event is unlike many other "open track events" held around the country and is gaining quite the reputation. We strive to ensure a non competitive and fun event for all. We encourage passengers, so even if you don't want to risk taking your baby on the track, you can still experience the thrill of being on track. This is a timed event with no door to door racing. Want to drive your car, but haven't done it before? Come on out. I will personally make sure you get the help and the coaching you need to get out there and be safe. Male or female, 16 (and licensed) to 100 (and licensed), all beginners are welcomed. No need to worry about being the only one, we usually have 4-6 track virgins every year. Worried about your car? This track was built by two brothers in the 80's for motorcycles. It was designed and constructed without the use of walls or barriers. The highest speed for most cars is in the low 90's. You could suffer a grass stain or mechanical problems, but it's not likely. 4 years - so far we have lost one race engine (faulty part) and two chin spoilers out of 160+ cars. Car preparation for the event is usually simple and mainly involves safety checks. If nothing else just come out and have a good laugh at all of the folks who really think they are Mario Andretti!!!!

I would like to wrap things up by saying that I and the other officers are always open for questions and comments. GRMC is here for all of us to enjoy. I hope you take some time this year to participate and enjoy it with us. Be sure to wear your GRMC gear so everyone knows which club you're with!
